# **LEAD AND COPPER RULE REVISIONS**

Under the EPA's Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR), it is **required** that all water systems in the United States complete an inventory of the materials used in water service lines, on both the portion of the service line owned by the Crab Orchard Utility District (COUD), and the portion on private property that is owned by the customer.

**This can only be completed with the assistance of everyone served by the Crab Orchard Utility District water lines.**

The inventory will document if pipes are made of lead, galvanized steel, copper or non-lead materials (Black Roll Pipe, PVC, PEX etc.). Crab Orchard Utility does not anticipate finding lead service lines but is prioritizing investigations at homes built in the mid 1900s where the customer-owned portion of the service line is currently unknown. If a service line made of lead is identified, COUD will follow EPA's lead service line replacement plan.

So far, COUD has completed the inventory for about 4,000 service lines of the approximately 9,200 water service lines in the district's coverage area.
